### Mr. Davis Director's report:

- Thanks again for Aztec Jazz Festival for all of the help – there were about 50 groups participating – we have space for just 5 more. Band entry fees from the festival go into a separate account for Mr. Davis to off-set other costs.
- Photo retakes were done 1 week ago. We'll switch photographers after this.
- ColorGuard had a great couple of weeks – Vegas 2 weeks ago, then 2 more shows this past weekend. All will be returning this next fall except for 1 – and only 1 graduating Senior.
- Mr. Davis thinks everyone in band will also be returning - - guessing next year's Freshmen class will be between 48 – 50. This year's class was 46, we are graduating 18 – and a few Freshmen won't be returning – so estimation is next year we'll have approx. 138 in EEU total.
- Mrs. Watson at BYMS is retiring – Mr. Davis would like to present her something at the Big Band Blowout event. Mr. Davis is open to suggestions as to what to give her. Maybe a pillow that everyone signs.
- Concert Band Festival at PAC last week. All 3 groups got high excellents, just missed superior – but some of the bands got superior in sight reading.
- ColorGuard got 4<sup>th</sup> on Sat (by 100ths of a point) and 2<sup>nd</sup> on Sunday (by 100ths of a point) – they have Championships at the end of Spring Break.
- Jazz Band – a lot going on this month. There will be a few after-school rehearsals going on for Jazz I and II. Café Jazz Fest will be on April 20<sup>th</sup> here in the band room.
- Mon night Road to Reno concert – the same week as the Reno Jazz Fest – Jazz I & II and El Dorado I & II and Mt Sac at the PAC.
- Reno is 27<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup>.
- May 6 – Florentines Bar & Grill Jazz I plays - - then Big Band Blowout.
- Spring Concert will not include the Jazz bands.
- AP tests the Monday after the students return from Reno.
- May 4<sup>th</sup> new and returning members – rehearsal 4 – 6pm and then at 5pm will have a mandatory parent meeting for all of EEU Band and ColorGuard.
