

EEU Booster Meeting Minutes

Wed Oct 4, 2016

President Chris Corter called meeting to order at 7:02pm.

Motion to accept last meeting's minutes. Motion seconded and carried. Minutes accepted.

President's Report:

- Chris opened the meeting discussing the need for volunteers. Specifically need a volunteer to organize Gift Baskets for next year. Carrie Mullner will help to take the lead on obtaining ticket donations for Gift Baskets.
- Need to provide Pizza for 70 people. Tues Nov 1st at 6pm volunteer meeting. Pizza needed after for drumline for Band Pageant.
- Placentia Parade is Sat – will be hot – be sure to hydrate kids.
- Thurs Oct 27 is Homecoming FB Game – no field show that game. Still need 3 Sr. Parents response for Sr. Night at Homecoming.
- President Chris reminded he will be absent for the Nov meeting – so Jennifer will run the meeting.

1st VP Report – Uniforms:

- Jennifer and Colleen: Uniforms are almost done -2 new students joined in last 2 weeks so fitted them.
- Need to order buttons for replacement.

2nd VP Report – Fundraising:

- **See's Candies Fundraiser:** Please help kids sell – and need donations for incentives for kids who sell a lot – need about 15 prizes like Cinema tickets, Starbucks, In-N-Out Gift Cards, etc – all approx. \$10 to \$15 value. Also suggest Denny's as the kids love going there after games. They will use additional gift cards for the Holiday Gift Baskets. Also recommend parents help sell See's at work. Some items in the fundraiser bring 50% profit – especially the small chocolate boxes. When the chocolates arrive, need volunteers to come help sort boxes per kid. We make as much \$\$ selling one \$7 box as we do selling \$20 box – so encourage to buy the little boxes. Last year we raised over \$5K. More envelopes are avail if needed. Suggest they make great gifts for Christmas. John and Amy Todd will take the lead on See's – thank you so much!!
- **Quartermania for Feb 3rd:** Carrie to take lead on this fundraiser. Goal to raise \$8K.
- **Movie Night:** Possible idea at to host this as a fundraiser at Cinema City – possibly during Thanks or Xmas break as lots of kids.
- **Clothes for Cause** \$1,346 was raised (Goal was \$2,000). We have option of doing a Spring Cleaning Fund Raiser along the same lines. Another option would be to go with Savers who takes HH goods as well. They either bring a trailer or we tell people to drive to Valley View to donate. Recommend to give advance notice so people save stuff up to donate. Question about receipts – whether they'd come from Savers or from EEU.
- **Wrapping Committee:** Angela Hatmaker will take lead on prepping baskets – and need a new person to be understudy to wrap things next year. Nancy has volunteered to help be on the committee.
- **E-Waste event:** Extremely successful and well run - - we don't have a \$\$ amount yet. Last year we made \$1K with 1 ½ trucks and this year we filled 2 trucks. So we should make more this year.

Treasurers Report:

- Chipotle only made \$150 vs last year \$400. Timing was a challenge.
- Farm Fresh \$329 deposited now – will deposit twice a year.
- 26 Families signed up for e-scrip – so far, for EEU \$152, families made \$224 – already made more than Scrip for all of last year. We will go to twice a month orders from this point forward which we'll email to the EEU. If you need something urgently then a separate order can be placed if willing to pay \$13 shipping. Will send another email to EEU to remind parents to sign-up.
- Expenses: Paid Field Shows, Color Guard, Lift Rental, new Flags,
- \$28,095 on performance donations 60% of goal. This week is payment # 2 due.

Secretary Report:

Mr. Davis report:

- **Placentia Parade Commission Memo:** Jackets will not be allowed due to last year's heat related issues. Weather forecast is 95 for Sat.
