EEU Parent / Booster Meeting Minutes

Meeting called to order at 4:30pm

Presidents Report:

Reminder if you're not getting emails – go to the EEU website to sign up.

Jazz Auditions will be held this week.

Next week Uniform Fitting happening Mon / Tues / Wed evenings. Reminder to bring your forms with you.

Week from Thursday is Preview Night – we'll have BBQ burgers / hot dogs etc available for dinner.

1st Football game is the first week of school – the 31st.

Next Parent Meeting will be on Sept 5th – we ask that at least 1 parent attend.

Sept 16th we will have an E-Waste and Savers Event for fundraising.

Request for Volunteers – specifically for Uniform Night – and during Football Games to coordinate a half-time raffle. We also need a graphics person. We need Roadies as well to help with loading / unloading.

Volunteer Requirement: We ask that every family plan to put in a minimum of 8 hours of volunteering throughout the year.

E-Scrip: Allows you to get \$\$ back into your own child's account. \$\$ in your account rolls year over year - - but must be used by Graduation.

Logo Wear – Kristi Glenday has a table at Uniform Fitting night – requirement that all students have an EEU sweatshirt. Other Logo Wear items will be available for purchase as well. Parents can also order Show Shirts as desired. Kids will automatically receive them as part of their EEU fees. Color Guard does not need the same EEU student sweatshirt as they will be getting their own.

To wear under uniform: White t-shirt V-Neck; black socks up to calves and black shorts. Hair needs to be completely up under hats.

Fund-raising: need help from everyone so performance donations don't have to increase. Trailer ads are available; Sponsorships available; Football Game raffle – need person to coordinate and also items to raffle off. If anyone works at Disneyland and has a child in the program, they can help solicit a grant. A lot of other businesses that parents work for might have matching opportunities available.

Treasurer Report: Budget is attached. Motion to approve budget as submitted; Seconded. Budget approved as presented.

Directors Report: Great first day of camp. 67% are freshman and sophomores. 130 students in EEU this year. Please notify Mr. Davis if student's having challenges with homework / classes. Half-time show is Le Guillotine – loosely based on the French Revolution.

Very busy end of Oct / beg of November. We have 5 competitive shows this season – all within 14 days.

First day of school there is no zero period – otherwise the day will operate as normal.

Thursday (Preview Night Day), camp ends at 3pm - - dinner served at 5pm; students back at 5:45pm to warm-up and then show starts at 6pm.

Placentia Parade is the only parade we'll do this year. Also hopefully the Disneyland Parade (to be confirmed) and the competitive band review.

Next Friday – camp ends at 12noon. At 12noon there is a student hosted BBQ – each student should bring \$5. Pool is reserved from 12noon to 2pm – Students avail for pick-up at 2pm.

Schedules for the year – available online. All events in the schedule are required. Please review the schedule – especially around the holidays – there's a Championship show the Saturday before Thanksgiving.

Confirmation classes – most churches offer Mon or Weds evenings – can conflict with Weds rehearsal which ends at 7pm. Please don't leave early to attend.

Club Sports - - if your student plays EHS sports, then when there's a game, they can play in the game. Club Sports however, EEU takes priority.

Classroom stuff - - if student's phone goes off in class, the student has to bring brownies the next day. No fidget spinners or phones during classes or breaks.

Schedule of skills – year long series of compulsory skills required of all students. Students play skills as many times as needed to pass. They have all year to pass skills –worth 20% of grade. Or can play for 3 people for 8 to 10 minutes to make up for skills.
