 - Color Guard in Huntington Beach this Sat. Next weekend is Championships Bren Center UCI.
 - Jazz is ramping up the most – next Thurs is Café Jazz Tech here in the Band Room – hang banners, black-out windows, showcase concert for the combos heading to Reno. \$2 for soda and a slice. Gives a good opp for students to get some practice.
 - 21st Fullerton Jazz Festival – schedule went out today.
